Now Hiring: Adult Psychologist

If you are a great fit for this role, you will be responsible for independently providing a high-standard of evidence-based psychological treatment to adult clients across a range of mental health presentations. As well as having highly developed clinical skills, you may have a specific area of clinical interest that you wish to pursue and develop, and we are open to supporting you with that.

The Role:

- Working from our brand new offices on Pirie Street in Adelaide CBD, you'll provide evidence-based, focused psychological strategies (CBT, psycho-education, relaxation strategies, skills training, interpersonal therapy) to adult clients (18 years and above) referred under a GP Mental Health Care Plan or under other funding arrangements, eg. Private health and NDIS.
- An interest in working with adults with a new diagnosis of Autism or ADHD due to our referrals from our assessments.
- This may also involve the development, facilitation and evaluation of group treatment programs.
- You will maintain accurate case notes for clients using an electronic clinical record and according to Practice protocols and professional standards.
- You will participate in peer supervision meetings, and participate in planned case conferences with GPs and other health professionals involved in the client's care as required.
- We will require to you provide written reports to the client's referring GP with information regarding assessments undertaken, treatment provided; and recommendations on future management of the client's disorder, according to Practice protocols.
- Being part of our exciting and growing team, you will be able to contribute to service planning, policy and procedure development and other administrative functions relevant to service provision (including assessment procedures, protocols for individual and group treatment programs, pathways and procedures for referral).
- You will understand and comply with strict confidentiality and privacy obligations under relevant legislation and as outlined in Supported Minds policies, procedures and agreements.

- 6. Ability to use a desktop computer, with familiarity with MS Office applications and capacity to learn how to use a new clinical software package for keeping of electronic client records.
- 7. Ability to work independently as well as collaboratively as part of a multidisciplinary team.
- 8. Demonstrated written and verbal communication skills including the ability to ensure that information is passed on to others who should be kept informed and to express yourself clearly and appropriately in verbal and written interactions.
